Product Description

Columbia Compost is produced using a controlled decomposition process of plants, straw, and pulped wheat straw under permit from the jurisdictional health department.

Physical Properties (full analysis available)

- Low salt content
- Neutral pH
- Valuable NPK and trace nutrients
- Contains beneficial fungi and bacteria
- Holds moisture and provides a slow release of nutrients to plants

Columbia Compost End Uses

- Soil amendment for gardens, lawns, and flowers
- Top dress to hold moisture and suppress weeds
- May be used as a potting medium if properly applied (see label sheet for proper uses of compost)
